CALL FOR APPLICATIONS 001/2026/MPFMC

The Coordination of the Professional Master's Program in Pharmacology (MPFMC), School of Biological Sciences, Universidade Federal de Santa Catarina, announces the opening of the application process and selection exam for the Master's degree program, from the date of publication of this Call for Applications until **November 26th, 2026**, with admissions available for the 2027 class.

1. APPLICATIONS

1.1. Target audience. The MPFMC, which is part of CAPES Area II of Biological Sciences (Biophysics, Biochemistry, Pharmacology, and Physiology), is primarily intended for graduates in the fields of Biological and Health Sciences. Detailed information is available at <https://mpfmc.paginas.ufsc.br/>.

1.2. Application procedure and deadline. Applications must be submitted exclusively through the CAPG System at <https://capg.sistemas.ufsc.br/inscricao/index.xhtml?cdCurso=41010085>, **from the date of publication of this Call for Applications until 11:59 p.m. (Brasília Time) on November 26, 2026**. The documents listed in Section 1.4 must be uploaded directly to the system in PDF format, with a maximum size of 20 MB per file, using the file naming conventions specified therein.

1.4. Required application documents.

1.4.1. Letter of Motivation. A statement of intent prepared by the applicant (maximum of 2 A4 pages, 12-point font, and 1.5-line spacing), including details on:

- the reasons for interest in the Professional Master's Program in Pharmacology;
- the contribution of the Professional Master's Program in Pharmacology to their professional career and to the place where they currently carry their professional activities;
- a minimum of one research project proposal to be developed during the Professional Master's Program in Pharmacology;
- the area of concentration to which they are applying, as listed in Table II of this Call for Applications;
- their availability of time and location to carry out the research project;
- professional and/or academic activities included in their Curriculum vitae that they consider relevant.

1.4.2. Undergraduate Degree Diploma. A copy of the Degree Certificate (Diploma) or Degree Completion Certificate or Certificate of Enrollment in the last semester of the Undergraduate program.

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1.4.3. A copy of the Identification Card and Individual Taxpayer Number. Brazilian applicants must submit a copy of their identity document and CPF; foreign applicants must submit a copy of their passport. (File name: applicant_name_identity.pdf)

1.4.4. Curriculum Vitae. A copy of the applicant's updated Curriculum Vitae (original or certified copies of supporting documents must be presented to the Selection Committee upon request). File name: applicant_name_CV.pdf)

1.4.5. Application for affirmative action places. Applicants must indicate whether they want to apply for a place reserved under the Affirmative Action and Equity Program. Those applying for these reserved places must include the SELF-DECLARATION FORM (Annexes II, III, IV, V e VI) with their application. Only one out of the five categories must be indicated (black and pardos or indigenous or quilombolas or people with disabilities or other categories of social vulnerability). The file should be named: applicant_name_self_declaration.pdf.

Notes:

1. Only applications submitted exclusively through the method and in the manner specified in Section 1.2 of this Call for Applications, and accompanied by all required documentation, will be accepted and approved.
2. The list of approved and unapproved applications will be posted on the MPFMC website (<http://mpfmc.paginas.ufsc.br>) from November 27th, 2026.
3. The curriculum vitae must be submitted in the Lattes Platform format (Lattes Platform).

2. THE SELECTION COMMITTEE, THE EXAMS SCHEDULE, AND THE STAGES OF THE SELECTION

The Selection Committee will be announced after the application period has closed.

This Selection Process consists of two stages:

- **STAGE 1 – WRITTEN EXAM** (December 7th, 2026), to be held in person in Room 12 (ground floor) of Block D (Pharmacology) of the Center for Biological Sciences (CCB);
- **STAGE 2 – EVALUATION OF CURRICULUM VITAE AND LETTER OF MOTIVATION, KNOWLEDGE IN PHARMACOLOGY FOLLOWED BY AN INTERVIEW WITH THE APPLICANT** (December 9th and 11th, 2026) via videoconference.

STAGE 1 – WRITTEN EXAM – December 7, 2026 – 8:30 AM – room 12 (ground floor) of Block D (Pharmacology) of the Center for Biological Sciences (CCB)

The written exam will consist of objective and/or essay questions on pharmacokinetics and pharmacodynamics. It will begin at 8:30 AM. on December 7, 2026, in Room 12 of Block D of the Biological Sciences Center and will last a maximum of two hours. It is essential that the candidate has their registration number on hand, as this number will be used for identification purposes.

Essay questions are evaluated by a committee of three faculty members based on the following criteria: conceptual accuracy, soundness of arguments, clarity of presentation, and quality of writing. The final



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grade for each essay question is calculated as the arithmetic average of the scores given by the evaluators. The answer key for any objective questions (if applicable) will be posted after the announcement of the written exam results.

STAGE 2 – EVALUATION OF CURRICULUM VITAE, LETTER OF MOTIVATION AND KNOWLEDGE IN PHARMACOLOGY, FOLLOWED BY AN INTERVIEW WITH THE APPLICANT
– December 9th and 14th, 2026

The **evaluation of the content of the applicant's Curriculum Vitae and Letter of Motivation** will be scheduled between 8 AM and 5 PM on December 9th and 11th, 2026, depending on the availability of the Selection Committee. This stage will be conducted via videoconference.

Notes:

1. The minimum passing grade in the STAGE 2 is six (6.0).
2. The scheduling of this stage will be done according to the alphabetical order of the applicant's names in the Selection Process. Applicants must contact the Selection Committee in advance to submit copies of each original supporting document for the activities mentioned in their *Currículo Lattes*.
3. In STAGE 2, applicants will be evaluated and interviewed on:
 - a) The information in the Curriculum Vitae, which must be verified with original documents or certified copies. The evaluation will be based on the following criteria:

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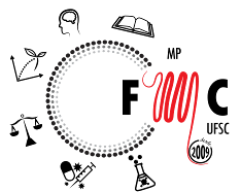

The score for items evaluated within a specified range will be determined by the Selection Committee, considering criteria such as relevance, quality, impact, scope, and the alignment of the activity with the Program's area of concentration and research lines, while respecting the maximum score established for each item.

- b) Clarity of the Letter of Motivation;
 - c) Your interest in the Professional Master's Program in Pharmacology and how it will contribute to your professional development;
 - d) Your initial proposal for the development of the thesis, including its feasibility and alignment with the research topic of one of the faculty members with an available place in this Call for Applications, items that must be formally described in the letter of motivation.
 - e) Knowledge of Pharmacology
3. The applicant must carry the original documents submitted during the application process, as well as the supporting documents for the activities described in the Currículo Lattes, such as diplomas, certificates, copies of publications, declarations regarding the duration of professional experience, teaching activities, internships (and/or supervision of internships), tutoring, etc.
4. The final grade in this stage will be equal to the arithmetic average of: i) the evaluation of academic and professional activities; ii) the clarity of the letter of motivation submitted by the applicant; iii) the applicant's understanding of the feasibility, relevance, alignment with the available places and research tracks in this Call for Applications, and potential limitations of the initial proposal for the developments of the master's thesis.
5. The tiebreaker criterion will be the grade obtained in STAGE 2.

3. APPROVALS

To be approved in this selection process, the applicant must achieve a minimum passing grade of six (6.0) in each of the two stages.

4. RANKING AND EXAM LOCATIONS

The final ranking will be determined according to the weighting/grades table below:

5. NUMBER OF PLACES PER FACULTY MEMBER AND AREA OF CONCENTRATION

This Call for Applications aims to fill up to **12 (twelve)** places in the Professional Master's Program in Pharmacology for the period from March 2027 to February 2029. Although the program has a larger number of accredited advisors interested in supervising students, the total number of available positions is limited to 12 (twelve). Accordingly, the allocation of positions per advisor will be carried out in compliance with this limit, within the respective areas of concentration presented in Table III.

1. There is no obligation whatsoever to fill all the available places in this selection.
2. Admission to the Professional Master's Program in Pharmacology depends on the availability of places within the desired research track, the applicant's ranking, and the capacity of supervisors.
3. Approved candidates may be reassigned to different areas of concentration and/or supervisors from those indicated in their application, provided that the supervisor(s) involved agree, positions are available, and the candidate's academic profile is compatible with the proposed research line or topic. Such reassignment will be carried out with the aim of making the best use of the positions available under this Call for Applications and does not guarantee that the candidate will be allocated to the area of concentration, research line, topic, or supervisor initially indicated.

6. PLACES RESERVED FOR AFFIRMATIVE ACTION AND EQUITY

6.1. Applicants opting for Affirmative Action and Equity places must indicate, at the time of application, in the specific field of the Application Form, whether they wish to compete for an Affirmative Action and Equity place, and may indicate only one category. The required documentation for each group, to be submitted at the time of application, is detailed below.



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6.2. Places reserved for black people, pardo people, indigenous people, and quilombolas (PPIQ)

6.2.1 Three (3) places are reserved for applicants who are black, pardo, indigenous or quilombola. Applicants in these categories compete simultaneously for these places, which will be allocated according to the descending order of final grades and, in the event of a tie, according to the criteria established in item 6.10.

6.2.2 Pursuant to Law no. 12.711/2012, as amended by Law no. 14.723/2023, self-declared quilombola people are included in the PPIQ category

6.3 Validation of self-declaration for black and pardo people

6.3.1 To request validation of their self-declaration as a Black Person at UFSC, the applicant must first indicate their self-declaration directly in the system by clicking the specific button and assuming responsibility for the accuracy of the information provided. The applicant must then submit the following documentation through the same system:

- a) Official photo identification document: The following documents will be accepted for identification purposes: Identity Card (RG), National Driver's License (CNH), Passport, Work and Social Security Card (CTPS), Professional Identity Card, National Registry of Foreigners (RNE), National Migration Registry Card (CRNM), among other equivalent documents.
- b) Video of the applicant: The applicant must record and submit a presentation video, in accordance with the instructions available in the tutorial. The video is an integral part of the ethnic-racial self-declaration verification process and must strictly comply with the established criteria to ensure its validity.

6.3.2 The validation of the self-declaration as a Black Person (black or pardo) will be carried out by the Self-declaration Validation Committee, specifically appointed by the Prorectorate for Affirmative Action and Equity (PROAFE) for this purpose, according to the following criterion: self-declared black or pardo applicants must present phenotypic traits that characterize them as belonging to the Black racial group. In accordance with the Supreme Court, the constitutionality of heteroidentification of applicants who self-declare as Black was established through the rejection of the Action for Non-compliance with Fundamental Precept no. 186, with phenotype, rather than ancestry, being the criterion adopted.

6.3.3 The initial analysis will be carried out by a first-level validation committee, based on the documents submitted. If there are doubts or a need for additional information, this committee may call the applicant for a remote interview, which will be recorded and conducted by a second committee specifically appointed for this stage. The recording may be used in the event of an appeal against rejection of the self-declaration. During the validation process, applicants must arrive in advance and may not be wearing a cap, hood, beanie, or any other item that conceals their face, and should preferably have their hair down. The presence of another person accompanying the applicant will not be permitted.

6.3.4 Applicants who have previously been approved by Black Validation Committees for undergraduate or graduate programs at UFSC, conducted by PROAFE using phenotypic criteria since 2017, **are exempt from undergoing a new validation process, provided that they submit proof of the previous approval for administrative validation.**



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6.4 Validation of self-declaration for indigenous people

6.4.1 Applicants classified for places reserved for self-declared indigenous people must, at the time of enrollment, prove their belonging to the indigenous people indicated in their application. For this purpose, they must indicate their self-declaration directly in the system by clicking the specific button and assuming responsibility for the accuracy of the information provided. The applicant must then submit the following documentation through the same system:

- a) Official identification document with photograph and signature of the applicant (front and back): The following documents will be accepted for identification purposes: Identity Card (RG), National Driver's License (CNH), Passport, Work and Social Security Card (CTPS), Professional Identity Card, National Registry of Foreigners (RNE), National Migration Registry Card (CRNM), among other equivalent documents.
- b) Declaration of Indigenous Belonging issued by three (3) indigenous leaders from the Indigenous Land to which the applicant belongs (ANNEX IV);
- c) Official identification document with photograph and signature (front and back) of each of the three indigenous leaders who signed the Declaration of Indigenous Belonging.

6.4.2 Proof of belonging to an indigenous people should, whenever possible, be recognized by the National Foundation of Indigenous Peoples (Fundação Nacional dos Povos Indígenas – FUNAI). In the case of indigenous peoples in the state of Santa Catarina, recognition may be certified by the Regional Association of Indigenous Peoples of the state. The Validation Committee may request additional documents or information deemed necessary for the analysis of the self-declaration.

6.4.3 A Declaration of Indigenous Belonging notarized by a notary public exempts the applicant from submitting the identification documents of the indigenous leaders.

6.4.4 The Validation Committee may request additional documents or information deemed necessary for the analysis of the self-declaration.

6.4.5 The validation of the self-declaration of indigenous people will be carried out by a Self-declaration Validation Committee appointed by PROAFE and specifically constituted for this purpose.

6.5 Validation of self-declaration for quilombola people

6.5.1 Applicants classified for places reserved for quilombola people must, at the time of enrollment, prove their residence in and/or belonging to the remaining quilombola communities indicated in their application. For this purpose, they must indicate their self-declaration directly in the system by clicking the specific button and assuming responsibility for the accuracy of the information provided. The applicant must then submit the following documentation through the same system:

- a) Official identification document with photograph and signature of the applicant (front and back). The following documents will be accepted for identification purposes: Identity Card (RG), National Driver's License (CNH), Passport, Work and Social Security Card (CTPS), Professional Identity Card, National Registry of Foreigners (RNE), National Migration Registry Card (CRNM), among other equivalent documents.



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- b) Declaration of Quilombola Belonging issued and signed by three (3) leaders of the Quilombola Community to which the applicant belongs.
- c) Official identification document with photograph and signature (front and back) of each of the three leaders who signed the Declaration of Quilombola Belonging.

6.5.2 Proof of belonging to the Quilombola Community should, whenever possible, be recognized by the Palmares Foundation or INCRA. In the case of quilombola communities in the state of Santa Catarina, recognition may be certified by the Association of Quilombola Communities of the state. The Validation Committee may request additional documents or information deemed necessary for the analysis of the self-declaration.

6.5.3 The validation of the self-declaration as Quilombola will be carried out by a Self-declaration Validation Committee specifically constituted for this purpose.

6.6 Places reserved for people with disabilities

6.6.1 One (1) place is reserved for applicants with disabilities. The place will be allocated to the validated applicant with the highest final grade and, in the event of a tie, according to the criteria established in item 6.10.

6.6.2 Definition and limitations. Pursuant to Law no. 13.146/2015, a person with a disability is considered to be someone who has a long-term physical, mental, intellectual, or sensory impairment that, when interacting with one or more barriers, may hinder their full and effective participation in society on an equal basis with others. Decrees no. 3.298/1999 and no. 5.296/2004 and Laws no. 12.764/2012, no. 14.126/2021, and no. 14.768/2023 also apply. Individuals who present only aesthetic deformities or sensory impairments that do not constitute an impairment or restriction to performance in previous learning processes, as well as individuals with specific functional disorders (dyslexia, dyscalculia, dysgraphia, attention deficit hyperactivity disorder), are not eligible to apply for this reserved place.

6.6.3 Special conditions for the selection stages. Any applicant, whether or not opting for Affirmative Action and Equity, may request special conditions at the time of application by indicating the disability they have, whether adaptations are required, and which adaptations are necessary, and by attaching a technical report proving such need. Requests will be considered according to feasibility and reasonableness criteria and will be analyzed by a multidisciplinary team, with the assistance of the Educational Accessibility Coordination (CAE) of PROAFE. The result will be communicated to the applicant by the date of confirmation of the applications.

6.7 Validation of self-declaration for people with disabilities

6.7.1 Applicants may be called for an interview by videoconference with the Self-declaration as People with Disabilities Validation Committee. The following documentation must be submitted:

- a) Self-declaration of person with a disability, as provided in Annex V of this Call for Applications.
- b) Medical report issued no more than twelve months prior to the application to this selection process, signed by a physician specialized in the applicant's disability. The clinical description must indicate the degree or level of disability, with explicit reference to the corresponding code of the International Classification of Diseases (ICD), as well as a description of the impact of the



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disability on functionality. The report must also contain the legible name, stamp, signature, and CRM registration number of the physician who issued the report.

- c) Applicants with Hearing Impairment (Deafness), in addition to the medical report, must submit the following examinations: tonal and vocal audiometry and immittance audiometry, carried out within twelve months prior to the application to this selection process. The examinations must contain the legible name, stamp, signature, and professional registration number of the professional who performed the examination.
- d) Applicants with Visual Impairment, in addition to the medical report, must submit an ophthalmological examination indicating visual acuity, carried out no more than twelve months prior to the application to this selection process, as well as the legible name, stamp, signature, and CRM registration number of the professional who performed the examination.
- e) For applicants with autism, the medical report must include, in addition to the specifications described in item b, information regarding communication, behavior, and interpersonal relationships, as well as an indication that the manifestations occurred before the age of 18.

6.8 Places reserved for transgender people

6.8.1 One (1) place is reserved for transgender people (transsexuals, travestis, transmasculine people, transgender people, and/or non-binary people), as a specific and separate category from the other modalities of vulnerability, pursuant to Normative Resolution no. 181/2023/CUn.

6.8.2 The place will be allocated to the validated applicant with the highest final grade and, in the event of a tie, according to the criteria established in item 6.10.

6.9 Common provisions

6.9.1 Foreign applicants. Foreign applicants may compete for the reserved places established in this section, subject to the same requirements and validation procedures applicable to other applicants.

6.9.2 Simultaneous competition. Applicants opting for Affirmative Action and Equity compete simultaneously for reserved places and Open Competition places. If they obtain a sufficient ranking for admission through Open Competition, admission shall necessarily take place through Open Competition, without occupying a reserved place and without prejudice to mechanisms for student retention and permanence.

6.9.3 Single category. Applicants opting for Affirmative Action and Equity must indicate, at the time of application, only one Affirmative Action and Equity category. Changes to the selected category after application will not be permitted.

6.9.4 Unfilled places. If there are not enough applicants enrolled, approved, or validated to fill the places reserved for a given category, the remaining places will be successively redistributed among the other Affirmative Action and Equity categories, prioritizing those with the lowest percentage of reserved places, until all possibilities for reservation have been exhausted. Once all categories have been exhausted, the places will be allocated to Open Competition.

6.9.5 Socioeconomic vulnerability. Applicants in a situation of socioeconomic vulnerability may opt for this category at the time of application. No specific place is reserved for this category in this selection



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process. The supporting documentation to be submitted to the Master's Selection Committee, in accordance with the provisions of this Call for Applications, includes: (a) proof of a scholarship granted by the University for All Program (PROUNI); (b) proof of a socioeconomic benefit intended for undergraduate students at public higher education institutions who are in a situation of socioeconomic vulnerability; or (c) proof of registration in the Federal Government's Single Registry (Cadastro Único – CadÚnico).

6.10 If more than one applicant is competing for the same place with a given supervisor in a specific research track, the applicant with the highest final grade will be selected, while respecting the places reserved for Affirmative Action and Equity. In the event of a tie in the final grade, the applicant with the highest grade in STAGE 2 will be selected. In the event of withdrawal by the selected applicant, the next highest-ranked approved applicant in the same research track may be called. If there is a research track for which no applicant has been classified, the supervisor responsible for that track may choose whether or not to make the place available to another applicant who has been classified in a different research track and has not been awarded a place. The Professional Master's Program in Pharmacology reserves the right to admit fewer applicants than the number of places indicated in this Call for Applications.

7. PUBLICATION OF FINAL RESULTS AND DURATION OF THIS CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

A list containing the names of the candidates approved and ranked in the selection process will be published on the MPFMC website (<http://mpfmc.paginas.ufsc.br>) starting December 14th, 2026, on a preliminary basis. The final result of the selection process will be subject to the completion of the affirmative action validation procedures, when applicable, and will be published subsequently, with publication expected in January 2027. This Call for Applications will remain valid for 120 days..

8. APPEALS

Appeals regarding any of the stages of the selection process (applications approval, STAGE 1 and STAGE 2) must be formally submitted (**Annex I**) to the Coordination of the Professional Master's Program in Pharmacology, via the Integrated Secretariat of the Graduate Programs of the School of Biological Sciences (email: processoseletivo.sipg@contato.ufsc.br), within 72 hours after the announcement of the results for the respective stage.

In cases where the appeal lead to a revision of the STAGE 1, resulting in the applicant's approval, the applicant must take part in STAGE 2 of the selection process, which will take place on December 9th and 11th, 2026, at times to be announced by the Selection Committee on the PPGFMC website (<http://mpfmc.paginas.ufsc.br/edital-de-selecao/>) and via email to the applicant.
